Archie Carroll is professor emeritus in the Terry College of Business at UGA. He retired after 33 years on the faculty, and he was retained part-time to continue serving as Director of the Nonprofit Management & Community Service program, which he had directed since 2000. Archie enjoys writing, reading, and golf. He writes a monthly column on business ethics for the Athens Banner-Herald, continues to revise his business ethics textbook (7th Edition), and he remains active in professional organizations.

Gene Michaels received his Ph.D. in microbiology from UGA and served for many years as a faculty member and administrator. He researched and taught medical microbiology and directed UGA's Office of Special Academic Programs, including the State Science Fair and Advanced Placement Teachers' Institute. Among many activities, he designed the official seals for our colleges of Arts & Sciences, Agriculture, and Education. Gene retired in 1998 and remains active in UGARA and other campus organizations.

Debra Watson worked in several departments during her career at UGA. Her last position was Accountant II in the Physical Plant Division's Business Office. Some of the things Debra enjoys doing are traveling, reading, solving puzzles, and cross-stitching.
